CURRENT CHALLENGES:

- **Limited Space:**
Lower School students learning in temporary modular buildings
- **Safety Concerns:**
Students must walk between buildings in all weather conditions
- **No Gymnasium:**
PE classes and recess canceled during rain, no space for athletics
- **Overcrowding:**
5th Grade, Resources, Middle and Upper School using trailers
- **Currently Missing Facilities:**
No dedicated library, art room, technology lab, nursing station



THE COST OF WAITING—EVERY DAY WE DELAY MEANS:

- More families turned away due to space limitations
- Students missing educational opportunities
- Safety risks during inclement weather
- Limited athletic and physical education programs

LOWER SCHOOL CLASSROOMS

- Jr. Kindergarten through 5th Grade
- Modern learning environments with educational technology
- Natural lighting and flexible learning spaces



FULL GYMNASIUM

- Complete with nets, bleachers, scoreboard
- Safe indoor space for PE and athletics
- Community gathering space for events



COMMUNITY SPACES

- Full cafeteria with kitchen and concessions
- Administrative offices
- No more walking between buildings!



SPECIALIZED LEARNING SPACES

- Dedicated library encouraging lifelong learning

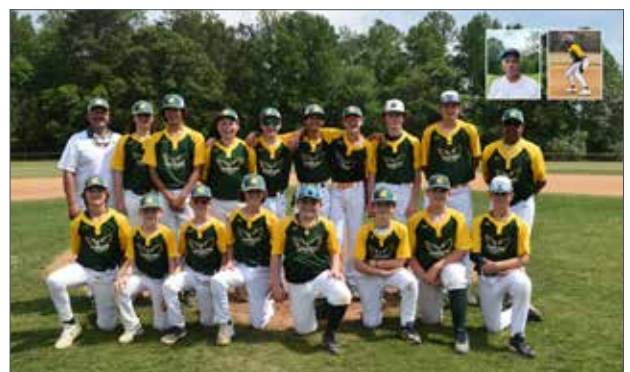
ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT
